My Dear People of God:

Pope Francis wrote: On the lips of the catechist the first proclamation must ring out over and over: “Jesus Christ loves you: He gave His life to save you; and now He is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you” (*Evangelii Gaudium*, 164). Without communication this message cannot be heard and we, as well as the world at large, need to hear this message. We need this enrichment and nourishment in our lives to help us “cope” with all the trials of daily life, while we await eternal life. The *Catholic Communication Campaign* is one way in which we can participate in the evangelizing mission of the Church. This is a National Collection but more than half of this collection is designated for our own diocesan communication needs.

Here in the Diocese of Santa Rose, we combine the *Catholic Communication Campaign* collection with another National Collection. The co-sharer in this collection is the *Catholic University of America*. The distance of California from Washington, DC makes it difficult for us to see our connection with the Catholic University of America but the Diocese does offer a contribution to the Catholic University each year in recognition of the good which it does for the Church of the United States.

DESDE EL ESCRITORIO DEL PADRE ROA

Trigésimo Primero Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

Leamos con atención parte de la Constitución Pastoral *Gáudium et Spes*, sobre la naturaleza de la paz.

La paz no consiste en una mera ausencia de guerra ni se reduce a asegurar el equilibrio de las distintas fuerzas contrarias ni nace del dominio despótico, sino que, con razón, se define como obra de la justicia. Ella es como el fruto de aquél orden que el

Creador quiso establecer en la sociedad humana y que debe irse perfeccionando sin cesar por medio del esfuerzo de aquellos hombres que aspiran a implantar en el mundo una justicia cada vez más plena. En efecto, aunque fundamentalmente el bien común del género humano depende de la ley eterna, en sus exigencias concretas está, con todo, sometido a las continuas transformaciones ocasionadas por la evolución de los tiempos; la paz no es nunca algo adquirido de una vez para siempre, sino que es preciso ir la construyendo y edificando cada día. Como además la voluntad humana es frágil y está herida por el pecado, el mantenimiento de la paz requiere que cada uno se esfuerce constantemente por dominar sus pasiones, y exige de la autoridad legítima una constante vigilancia.

Y todo esto es aún insuficiente. La paz de la que hablamos no puede obtenerse en este mundo si no se garantiza el bien de cada una de las personas y si los hombres no saben comunicarse entre sí espontáneamente y con confianza las riquezas de su espíritu y de su talento. La firme voluntad de respetar la dignidad de los otros hombres y pueblos y el solícito ejercicio de la fraternidad son algo absolutamente imprescindible para construir la verdadera paz. Por ello puede decirse que la paz es también fruto del amor, que supera los límites de lo que exige la simple justicia. La paz terrestre nace del amor al prójimo, y es como la imagen y el efecto de aquella paz de Cristo, que procede de Dios Padre. En efecto, el mismo Hijo encarnado, príncipe de la paz, ha reconciliado por su cruz a todos los hombres con Dios, reconstruyendo la unidad de todos en un solo pueblo y en un solo cuerpo. Así ha dado muerte en su propia carne al odio y, después del triunfo de su resurrección, ha derramado su Espíritu de amor en el corazón de los hombres.

Por esta razón todos los cristianos quedan vivamente invitados a que, realizando la verdad en el amor, se unan a aquellos hombres que, como auténticos constructores de la paz, se esfuerzan por instaurarla y rehacerla. Movidos por este mismo espíritu, no podemos menos de alabar a quienes, renunciando a toda intervención violenta en la defensa de sus derechos, recurren a aquellos medios de defensa que están incluso al alcance de los más débiles, con tal de que esto pueda hacerse sin lesionar los derechos y los deberes de otras personas o de la misma comunidad.
