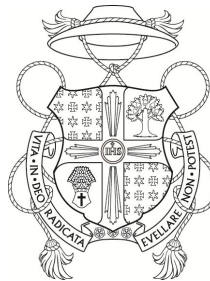
### ~GOLDEN OPPORTUNITIES~

# MY CATHOLIC FAITH

## JESUS IS GOD

### ~GOD COMMANDS NATURE~

[Today's articles are taken from the June 21, 2015 bulletin.] In today's Gospel, we see Jesus' command over nature. This indicates that Jesus was no mere human being, but God Himself. Let us look at this more deeply in terms of what Sacred Scripture itself tells us about **Jesus being true God and true Man** and what the Church teaches us about **Jesus' divine and human natures – the Hypostatic Union**.

### ~GOD COMMANDS NATURE~

"Jesus, says St. Mark, is not only the Creator but He is also the Controller of His creation. This should have told his readers, as well as the disciples, that Jesus was the God of the Old Testament. Note these verses: 'You rule over the surging sea; when its waves mount up, you still them.' (Ps. 89:9); 'He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed' (Ps. 107:29). The disciples were familiar with those passages as devout Jews. No matter how often they had used them, they could not have imagined seeing them fulfilled in the manner that they witnessed on this occasion." ## THE HYPOSTATIC UNION

### ~TWO NATURES~

"Jesus Christ of Nazareth is the founder and object of the Catholic Church. He is both true God and true man. Because he is God, we worship him as our Creator and Redeemer; because he is also man, he is our brother and like us in all things, sin alone excepted. In Catholic theology, the union of the divine nature and the human nature is explained as taking place in the Person of Jesus, who is the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, the Word of God. This is known as the "Hypostatic Union." The word, *hypostatis*, is a Greek word which means "person."

### ~A DIVINE PERSON~

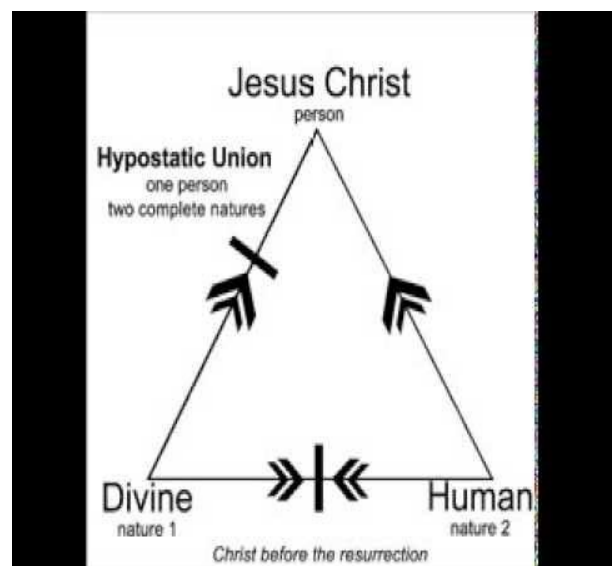
The Hypostatic Union had a profound effect on Jesus' human nature. Jesus Christ is a true man, but, because he is also God, he is no ordinary man. It is important to remember **that Jesus is not a human**

**n person like us; he is a divine Person.** Because of the Hypostatic Union, Jesus' human nature was endowed with an abundance of supernatural gifts; in fact, he has the perfection of all the virtues; St. John says that he is "full of grace and truth" (John 1:14). This raises questions about his human knowledge, human will, and human power.

### ~THE BEATIFIC VISION~

There is an ancient tradition in the Church, going back to the early Fathers. The human soul of Jesus is united to the Word of God, possessing the Beatific Vision of God from the first moment of his existence, in the womb of his mother, the Virgin Mary. The Beatific Vision of God is absolutely supernatural; it is granted to the angels in heaven, and to the saints in heaven. What the Fathers and theologians say is that Christ's soul possessed this vision of God from the first moment of its union with the divine Person of the Word, that is, from its conception in Mary. This means that Jesus was, at the same time, both a pilgrim on earth like us, and a possessor of the immediate vision of God, like the blessed in heaven. One of the consequences of his immediate vision of God is that he did not have the theological virtues of faith and hope, since faith and hope cease once there is vision and possession of God."

PADRES SANTOS

~MODELOS DE CONDUCTA~

En este día, el Día del Padre, tomemos un momento para mirar algunos grandes modelos de paternidad: San José y Santo Tomás Moro. Veamos primero al padre más grande y santo de todos los tiempos, el padre adoptivo de nuestro Señor, San José.

~SAN JOSÉ~

"San José es uno de los santos más queridos porque es el hombre que Dios eligió entre todos los demás para ser el guardián especial de Jesucristo encarnado y de su madre, la Santísima Virgen María. Fue el guardián humano de la Sagrada Familia, y debido a este sagrado vínculo familiar y a la misión divinamente otorgada, es también el padre adoptivo de todos los cristianos. En los Evangelios no se relata mucho sobre su vida, sin embargo, hay algunos santos y beatos que afirman haber sido favorecidos con visiones de la vida de San José. Quizá la más famosa sea la de la beata Ana Catalina Emmerich. Ana Catalina Emmerich (1774-1824) fue una monja agustina, mística y visionaria que tuvo la gracia de tener visiones inusuales con notable detalle de la vida de la Sagrada Familia. Como revelaciones privadas, estas visiones no tienen ninguna autoridad doctrinal, pero como parte de la creencia piadosa nos muestra un ejemplo de la perfecta virtud que San José ciertamente poseía para haber recibido tan noble cargo. He aquí un extracto de La Vida de la Santísima Virgen María que nos da una idea de la vida temprana de San José, descendiente de la casa real del rey David de Israel.

~UN HUMILDE HOMBRE DE DIOS~

José era muy devoto y rezaba fervientemente por la venida del Mesías. Estaba construyendo al lado de su vivienda una habitación más retirada para la oración, cuando se le apareció un ángel y le dijo que no lo hiciera, porque, como una vez el patriarca José había sido, por voluntad de Dios, nombrado supervisor de todo el maíz de Egipto, así él, el segundo José, debía ser ahora encargado del cuidado del granero de la salvación. José, en su humildad, no comprendió esto, y se entregó a la oración continua, hasta que recibió la llamada para trasladarse a Jerusalén y convertirse, por decreto divino, en el esposo de la Santísima Virgen". ~SANTO TOMÁS MORO~

"Tomás Moro estaba seriamente perplejo en cuanto a su vocación. Se sentía fuertemente atraído por la vida austera de los monjes cartujos, y se inclinaba también por los Frailes Menores de la Observancia; pero no parecía haber una verdadera llamada ni a la vida monástica ni al sacerdocio secular. Por aquel entonces, Moro conoció a un tal John Colt, de Essex, y se familiarizó con su familia, que incluía tres hijas. Moro dio ahora el paso decisivo de casarse, eligiendo a la hija mayor, Jane. Según su yerno, William Roper, consideraba a la segunda hija más hermosa, "pero cuando consideró que sería una gran pena y también una vergüenza para la mayor ver a su hermana menor preferida antes que ella en el matrimonio, entonces, por cierta piedad, se inclinó por ella, y poco después se casó con ella". No obstante, él y Jane fueron muy felices juntos; él se propuso enseñarle los logros literarios y musicales que debía tener la esposa de un hombre de la posición de Moro. Les nacieron cuatro hijos, Margaret, Elizabeth, Cecily y John. Además, varios hijos de amigos se criaron en su casa, y aquí Moro probó sus originales ideas en materia de educación. La casa fue durante años un centro de aprendizaje y cultura, y también de buen humor. Las niñas recibían una enseñanza tan cuidadosa como la de los niños, una práctica para la que Moro contaba con la autoridad de los "prudentes y santos ancianos", como San Jerónimo y San Agustín. A la hora de la comida, uno de los niños leía en voz alta un pasaje de las Escrituras, con un breve comentario; después se cantaba y se conversaba alegremente; las cartas y los dados estaban prohibidos. ## JESUS ES DIOS

~MANDAMIENTOS DE LA NATURALEZA DE DIOS~  
[Los artículos de hoy están tomados del boletín del 21 de junio de 2015] En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos el mandato de Jesús sobre la naturaleza.
