PASTOR'S CORNER

Happy Advent! When we think of Advent, we tend to immediately think of Christmas. Honestly, it's not your fault. We live in a culture and time when most people have forgotten about Advent. The stores put out Christmas decorations and gifts before Thanksgiving and it seems like it's a race to Christmas sometimes.

Yet, our Holy Mother the Church has a more excellent way. We build up our time expecting and waiting for Christ's coming at Christmas through a four Sunday celebration of the unfolding mystery. At home faith practices such as the Advent Wreath and the Jesse Tree can be great ways of engaging all the family members while also creating memories for life. Also, the reading of key passages of the Old Testament can help spiritually direct us through the season. In particular, I always like to say that nothing says Advent like Isaiah. If I'm not mistaken, Isaiah is the most quoted Prophet in the New Testament and it seems like it is the Prophet most clear about Jesus. Just think of passages like Isaiah 7:14, 11:1-9, and 52:13-53:12. Those passages are how Jewish people in the first century came to believe that Jesus was the Messiah for whom they had been waiting. When we read the Old Testament (especially the Prophets), we read the evidence that God left for us to find and follow His Son. May your Advent be blessed and holy,
