Diocesan Safe Environment Requirements & Compliance PARISH VOLUNTEERS

BE SURE TO REGISTER ONLINE <u>BEFORE</u> GETTING FINGERPRINTED

Because you will be volunteering in a capacity where you have direct contact with minors, you are required to be registered in the Diocesan database, to be fingerprinted for a background check and to be trained periodically. Compliance with these requirements MUST be met <u>BEFORE</u> working with minors. Failure to follow through with these requirements and to pass the background check will disqualify you from working with minors.

DO THIS FIRST BEFORE FINGERPRINTING:

Complete the Registration & Online Training Courses

- Access <u>www.steugenes.com</u> and click on Parish Life > Child Protection. Click on Online Training. This takes you to a separate website (<u>http://cmgconnect.org</u>).
 - a. You may also go directly to this site by clicking on this hyper-link and pressing the <u>Enter</u> button or typing it into the URL field in your browser and pressing <u>Enter</u>.
 - b. (Do NOT click Search or it may take you to the incorrect page.)
- 2. Find Your Diocese: select *Santa Rosa* and click *GO*. Complete the Set-Up Account information for log in and personal information.
 - a. Remember your user name and password because you will need it again. You may use your email address as your user name.
- 3. Show your affiliation as Volunteer of St. Eugene's Cathedral (not the school).
 - a. However, if you also volunteer or work for other Diocese' locations, make sure you register with your *primary* volunteer location—where you work the most hours.
 - b. If St. Eugene's parish is a *secondary* location, do not select it as your site.
- 4. Complete the Safe Environment Curriculum training module shown. Choose 2020 Safe Environment-Santa Rosa. This may take approximately 1 3 hours. It can be done in increments. If you log off and log back in, you should be taken back to where you left off. (There is an option for a Spanish version of the training.)
 - a. Be sure to click through the entire training module to the end so that the system detects that you have completed it.
 - b. If you are volunteering as a driver on a field trip, you should also complete the Defensive Driving Curriculum course. And you must provide the parish office with a copy of your insurance card and a copy of your driver's license.
- 5. Expect to be retrained in approximately one/two years. No need to register again. Just use the user name and password to access the site when you are asked to do so again.

Fingerprinting/Background Checks

- 1. Complete the Applicant information on the Request for Live Scan form.
- 2. Make an appointment with a fingerprinting agency for live-scan fingerprinting. A list of fingerprinting agencies is provided on the website. We recommend TruScan in Santa Rosa for the fastest service & turnaround time—no appointment is necessary there. Fees are your responsibility.
- 3. Have the fingerprinting completed. Volunteers are only required to have a Department of Justice (DOJ) report. The law enforcement office will send the paperwork to the DOJ for a background check. The report is sent directly to the Diocese and is held confidential in their office.
- 4. Should there be a problem with your prints or background check, you will be advised.
